Introduction

Work to construct the new Baird Family Hospital and ANCHOR Centre began in January 2021. To allow for this work to start safely two key changes have been made:

- One-way road system to a section of the campus.
- Change to pedestrian access to Foresterhill Road from Westburn Road.

Please see the information included in this booklet that explains access to the site for public vehicles, pedestrians and emergency vehicles.

Public Vehicles

The road leading to the Emergency Department (ED – also known as Accident & Emergency) accessible from Foresterhill Road is now a one way system. This road will be accessible ONLY to emergency vehicles, public vehicles requiring access to ED (or the Fracture Clinic) and delivery vehicles.

Due to the one way system, access to the Emergency Department is via Foresterhill Road or from Ashgrove Road West by using the loop road. Please refer to the map.

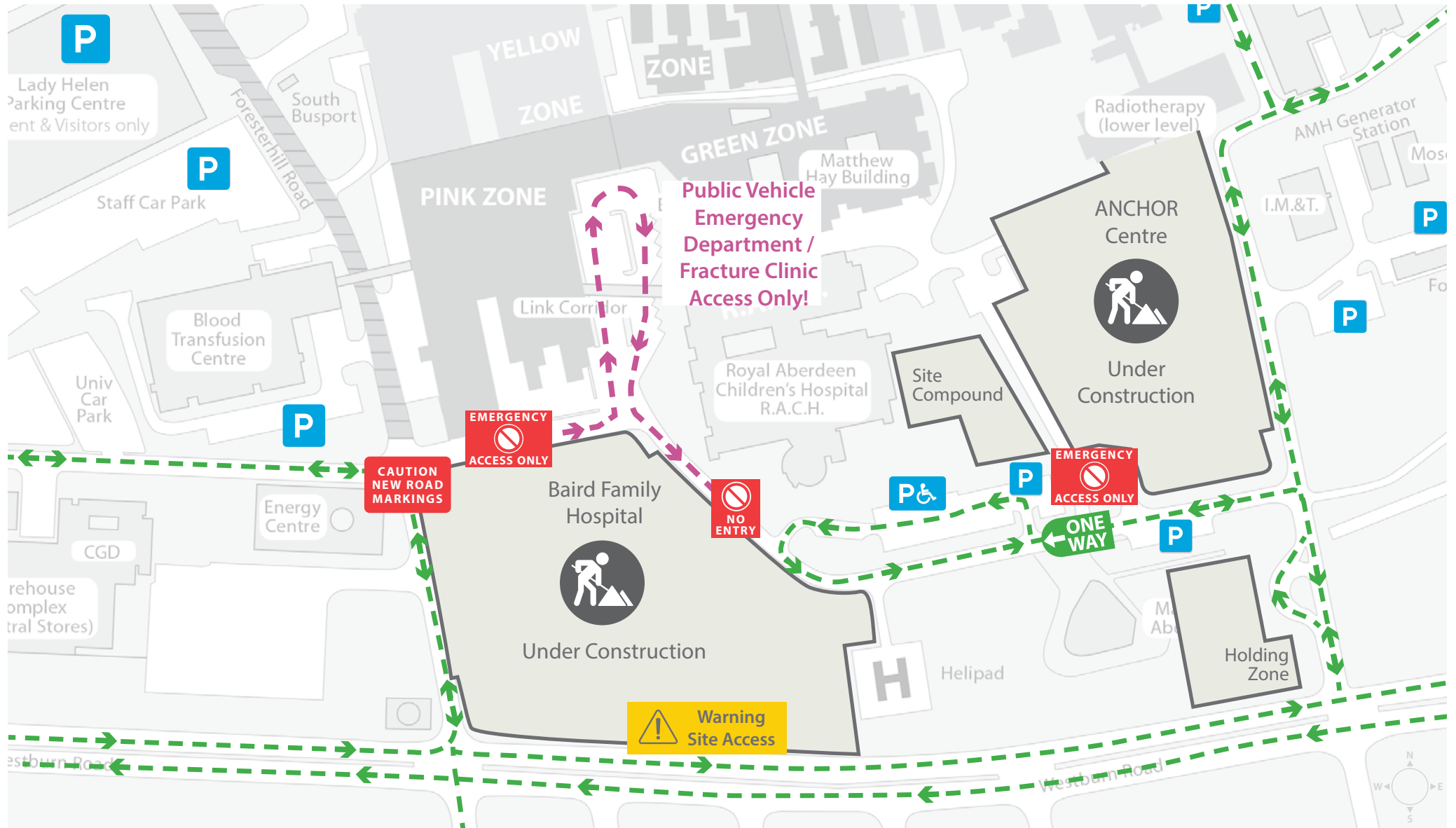
Access to the Royal Aberdeen Children's Hospital (RACH) car park will remain unaffected during these works. People are reminded that parking is available in the Lady Helen Parking Centre and where possible patients and visitors are encouraged to use this facility.

Pedestrian Footpaths

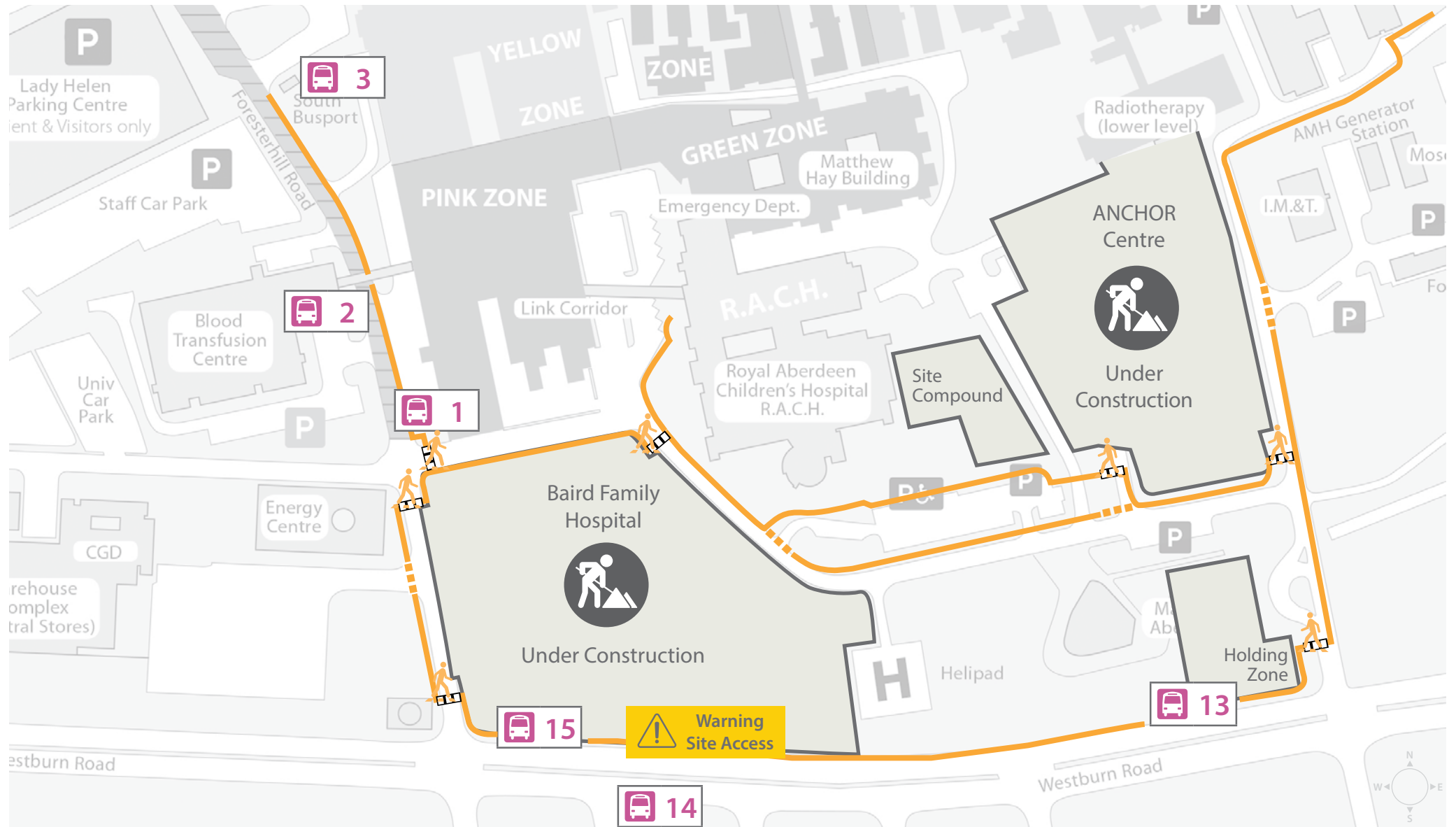
(Foresterhill Road from Westburn Road)

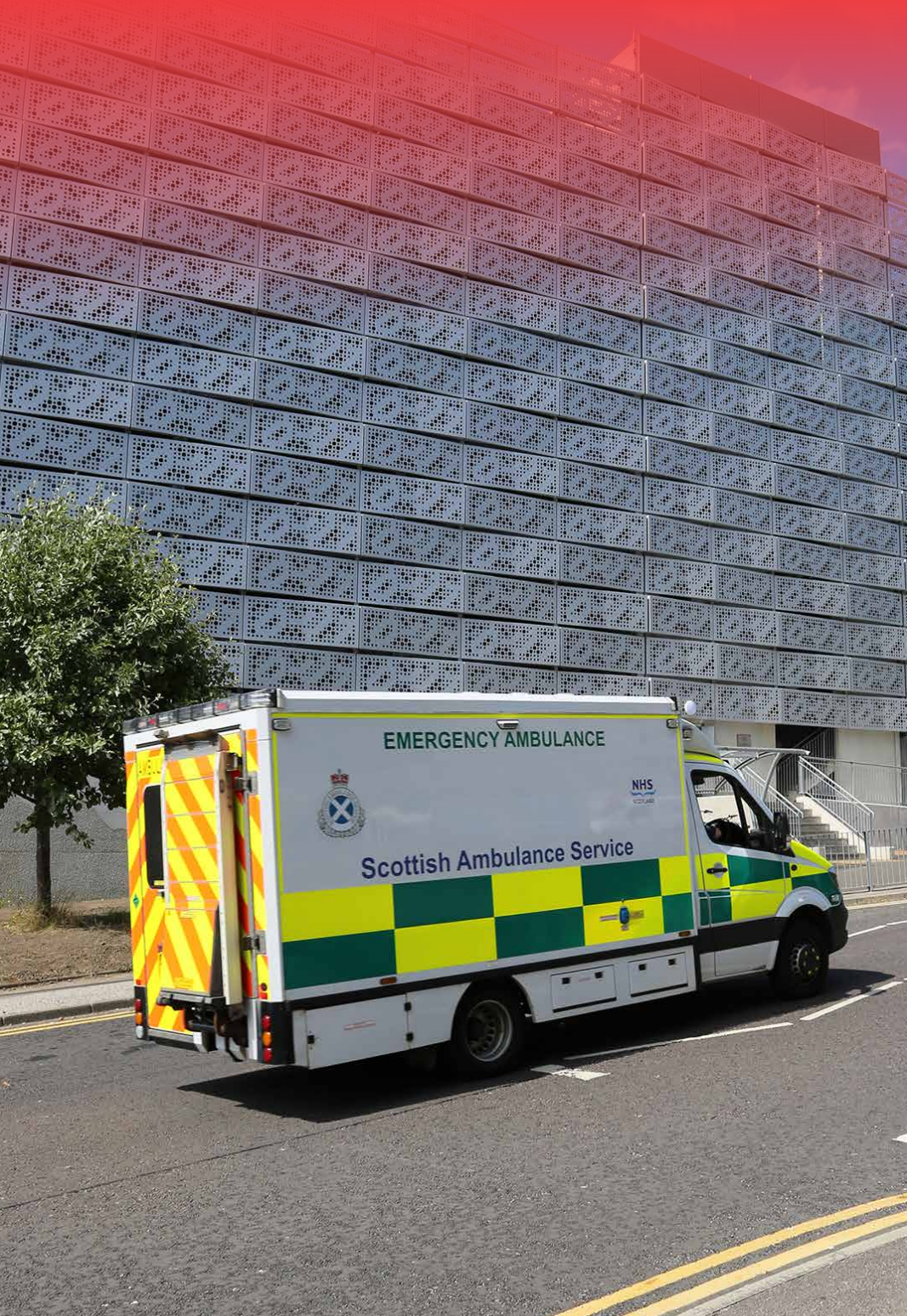
The pedestrian footpath on the east side of Foresterhill Road accessible from Westburn Road will close. The pedestrian footpath on the west side of Foresterhill Road will remain open and a new zebra crossing is now in place to allow pedestrians a way of crossing the road to continue their journey as normal.

Information for Emergency Services

The road leading to the Emergency Department (ED) accessible from the Foresterhill Road junction is now a one way system.

This road is accessible **ONLY** to **emergency vehicles, public vehicles requiring access to ED and delivery vehicles accessing the pink zone loading bay area.**

Vehicles leaving ED and the pink zone loading bay will be required to turn left down past The Royal Aberdeen Children's Hospital (RACH).

Due to the one way system, access to the Emergency Department and the pink zone loading bay will be via Foresterhill Road or from Ashgrove Road West by using the loop road as appropriate. Please refer to the map.

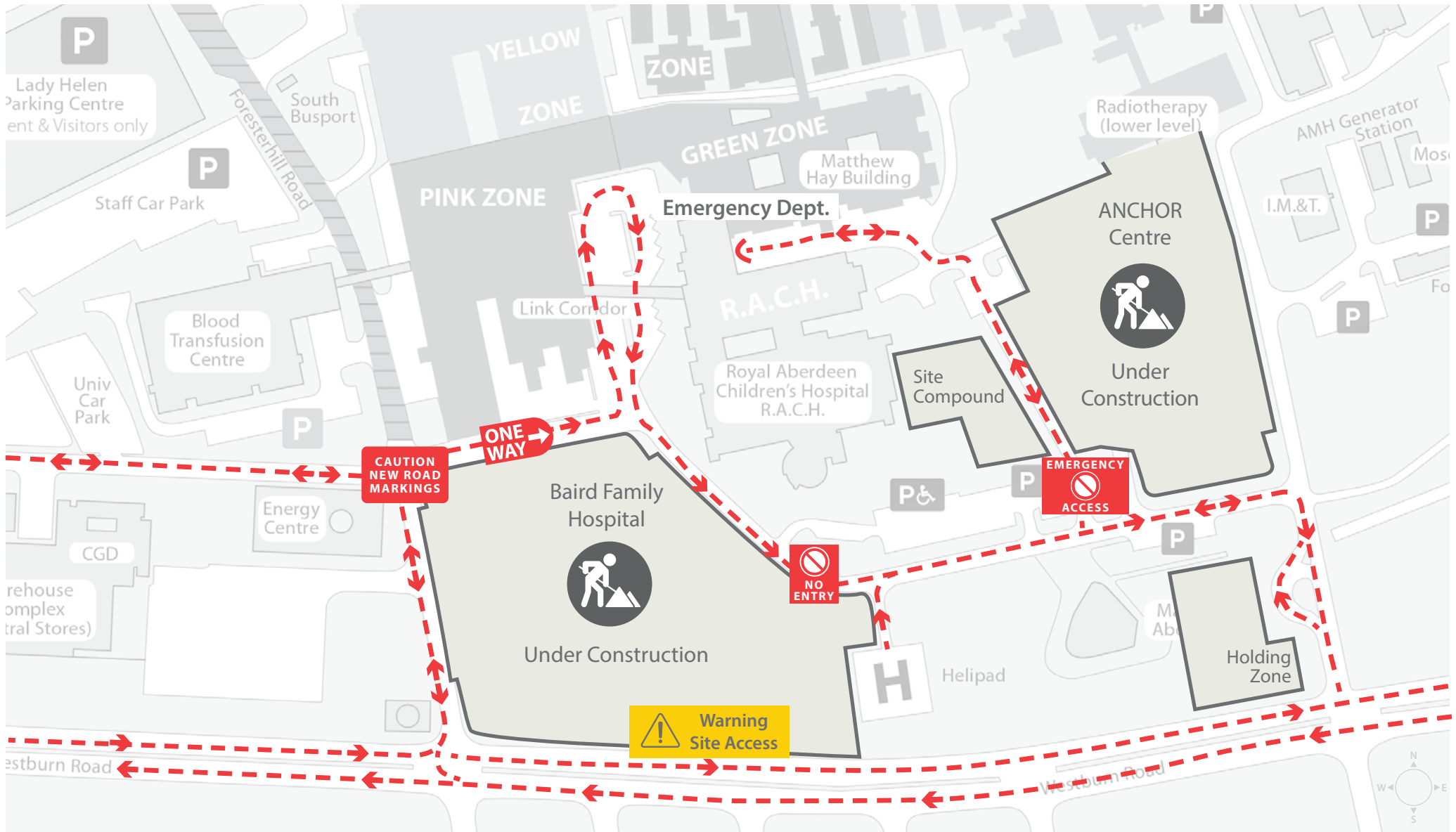
Helicopter Arrivals

On arrival of a helicopter the Scottish Ambulance Service will make the decision to go either via the 'Haul Road' which will take them to the rear of RACH and into ED or they may exit onto Westburn Road and enter ED via the Foresterhill Road junction.
